

**Guideline Fees for Lasting Powers of Attorney ('LPAs') (as at Oct 2021)**

	<b>One client</b>	<b>Two clients</b>
<b>One LPA</b>  (Property & Financial Affairs <b>or</b> Health & Welfare) includes registration	<b>£650</b> plus VAT	<b>£1,050</b> plus VAT
<b>Both LPAs</b>  (Property & Financial Affairs <b>and</b> Health & Welfare) includes registration	<b>£1,000</b> plus VAT	<b>£1,600</b> plus VAT
<b>Additional fee (if requested)</b>  Acting as certificate provider (per person not per LPA)	<b>£100</b> plus VAT	<b>£200</b> plus VAT

**The Guideline Fees include:**

- initial meeting to:
  - take instructions;
  - provide advice tailored to your personal circumstances;
  - explain the roles of the different people involved in LPAs eg. attorneys, certificate provider.
- sending draft LPA(s) to you with a full letter of advice;
- guiding you so your LPA(s) are signed correctly and in the right order;
- acting as your certificate provider if requested and appropriate (extra charge – see above)
- preparing the registration form for your LPA(s) and registering your LPA(s) at the Office of the Public Guardian ('OPG');
- providing a certified copy of each LPA which can be used just like the original;
- storing your LPA(s) for as long as required.

**The Guideline fees don't include**

- registration fee charged by the OPG of £82 per LPA (which can be reduced or waived in certain circumstances).
